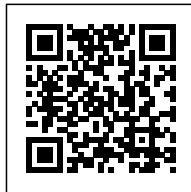


# ABKHAZIA

Abkhazia is a country in [Europe](#). The official name of Abkhazia is the Republic of Abkhazia. It shares borders with [Georgia](#). The people of Abkhazia are called Abkhaz. The country is situated on the Eastern coast of the Black Sea, south of the Greater Caucasus mountains in Northwestern Georgia.

Etymology discusses where a term is considered to have originated from and how its meaning has changed over time. Etymology has been a factor in the naming of countries all across the world, and Abkhazia has also been influenced. The etymology of Abkhazia can be defined as; The Abkhazians call their homeland Аҧсны (Apsny, Asny), popularly etymologized as "a land/country of the soul", yet meaning "a country of mortals (mortal beings)".

An ethnicity is a group or sub-group of people who are connected based on common characteristics which may include religion, origin, language, traditions, or culture. The ethnic groups in Abkhazia include Russians, Armenians, Georgians, Ukrainians, and Belarusians.

Abkhazian Air Force is the national airline of Abkhazia. The national colors of the country are green and white. The ISO code of the country is GE-AB.

Abkhazia is known for its beaches, warm climate, seacoast resorts, and attractive landscape. The national dish of Abkhazia is Mamalyga, and the national instrument is Ayumaa.

The country has the time zone UTC+3 (MSK) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Abkhazia is divided into 7 provinces. The capital of the country is Sukhumi, which is also the largest city in Abkhazia.

The literacy rate in Abkhazia is 99.7%.

The country's total area is 8,665 km<sup>2</sup> (3,346 sq mi), and the total population is 245,246. The country's average elevation is 1,000 m (3,281 ft.), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; The topography is varied as it ranges from the lowlands around the Black Sea to the high peaks in the north. The country's usual climate is subtropical.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Abkhazia has a 200 km of coastline.

The Abkhazian apsar serves as the national unit of currency, and the National Bank of the Republic of Abkhazia is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Abkhazia is .abkhazia.su and the country code is +7. Arash is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Abkhaz State Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Abkhaz State Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Abkhazia is the Cherkesska, and 30 September is designated as National Day.

In Abkhazia, the majority of the population practices Islam & Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Abkhazia has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Abkhazia's national bird is the Golden eagle (unofficial), while its national animal is the Bear. The national flower is Mimosa (unofficial). The highest peak is Mount Agepsta.

Mythical creatures can be found in the literature and mythologies of many different nations. They represent imaginative representations of various creatures, humans, or hybrids. They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Abkhazia is Abraskil.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Abkhazia and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Football is considered the country's national sport.

Poetry is a highly valued form of art, and many poets are considered significant national symbols of the country. The national poet of Abkhazia is Linguist Dmitry Gulia.

The country's national anthem was written by Gennady Alamia, and composed by Chkadua.

The country's national hero is Vladislav Ardzinba.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Freedom Square is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

The tourism slogan of the country is "Reveal Your Own Russia" whereas, "Workers of the world, unite" is the official motto of the country.

Alexander Ankvab is the current Prime minister of Abkhazia, and Aslan Bzhania is the President.

Abkhazia has declared Abkhaz and Russian as the country's official languages.
