The country's total area is 652,230 km² (251,830 sq mi), and the total population is 38,928,346. The country's average elevation is 1,885 m (6,184 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly rugged mountains; plains in the north and southwest. The country's usual climate is arid to semiarid: with cold winters and hot summers.

The Afghan afghani serves as the national unit of currency, and Da Afghanistan Bank is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Afghanistan is .af and the country code is +93. Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of Afghanistan serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of Afghanistan is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Afghanistan is the Khet partug and Perahan o tunban, and 19 August is designated as National Day. In Afghanistan, the majority of the population practices Islam as their religion.

Mausoleums are one of the most significant historical landmarks. The national mausoleum of Afghanistan is Timur Shah Mausoleum. The country's national hero is Ahmad Shah Massoud.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Mazar-e-Sharif, Shrine of Ali (The Blue Mosque) is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

Afghanistan is a member of the <u>Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC)</u>, <u>South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC)</u>, and <u>United Nations (UN)</u>.
