
## **ANGUILLA**

Anguilla is a country in <u>North America</u>. The people of Anguilla are called Anguillans. The country is situated in the Caribbean, between the Caribbean Sea and the North Atlantic Ocean, east of Puerto Rico.

Anguilla is known for its spectacular coral reefs and beaches. The national dish of Anguilla is Pigeon peas and rice. Rum punch, in addition to being a traditional beverage, is one of the country's national drinks. The national instrument of Anguilla is Buleador, Steel drums.

The country has the time zone UTC-4 (AST) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Anguilla is divided into 14 districts. North Side is Anguilla's largest city, while The Valley serves as the capital.

The literacy rate in Anguilla is 95.4%.

The country's total area is 91 km<sup>2</sup> (35 sq mi), and the total population is 15,094. The country's average elevation is 33 m (105 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Flat and low-lying island of coral and limestone. The country's usual climate is tropical; moderated by northeast trade winds.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Anguilla has 61 km of coastline.

The Eastern Caribbean dollar serves as the national unit of currency, and the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB) is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Anguilla is .ai and the country code is +1-264. Dolphin is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Anguilla Heritage Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Anguilla Heritage Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Anguilla is the Madras, Guayabera, and 19 December is designated as National

Day. In Anguilla, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Anguilla has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Anguilla's national bird is the Zenaida dove, while its national animal is the Fallow deer . The national flower is the Tabebuia heterophylla, whereas Sugar apple is the country's national fruit. The national tree of Anguilla is the White cedar, and the highest peak is Crocus Hill.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Anguilla and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Boat Racing is considered the country's national sport.

Ronald Webster is the founder of Anguilla. The country's national anthem was written by Alex Richardson, and composed by Alex Richardson.

The national hero of the country is Robert Llewellyn Bradshaw.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Fountain Cavern National Park is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

The tourism slogan of the country is "Tranquillity Wrapped in Blue" whereas, "Unity, Strength and Endurance" is the official motto of the country.

Ellis Webster (Premier) is the current Prime minister of Anguilla, and King Charles III (Monarch) is the President.
