

Armenia is a country in <u>Europe</u>. The official name of Armenia is the Republic of Armenia. It shares borders with 4 countries: <u>Georgia</u>, <u>Azerbaijan</u>, <u>Iran</u>, and <u>Turkiye</u>. The people of Armenia are called Armenians. The country is situated in Southwestern Asia, between Türkiye (to the west) and Azerbaijan.

The country has the time zone UTC+4 (AMT) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Armenia is divided into 10 provinces, 1 autonomous city, and 503 municipalities. The capital of the country is Yerevan, which is also the largest city in Armenia.

The literacy rate in Armenia is 99.7%.

The country's total area is 29,743 km² (11,484 sq mi), and the total population is 2,963,243. The country's average elevation is 1,792 m (5,879 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Armenian Highland with mountains; little forest land; fast-flowing rivers; good soil in the Aras River valley. The country's usual climate can be described as; Highland continental, with hot summers, and cold winters.

The Armenian dram serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of Armenia is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Armenia is .am and the country code is +374. Mount Ararat; eagle; the lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The History Museum of Armenia serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The History Museum of Armenia is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Armenia is the Taraz, and 28 May is designated as National Day. In Armenia, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Armenia has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Armenia's national bird is the Eagle, while its national animal is the Golden eagle. The national flower is the Marshmallow plant, whereas Apricot Prunus is the country's national fruit. The national tree of Armenia is the Silver leaf poplar, and the highest peak is Aragats Ler.

They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Armenia is Dev.

King Argishti I is the founder of Armenia. The country's national anthem was written by Mikael Nalbandian, and composed by Barsegh Kanachyan.

Mausoleums are buildings dedicated to holding someone's remains. It serves as a reminder of the nation's revolutionary fighters who sacrificed their lives for the country. Mausoleums are one of the most significant historical landmarks. The national mausoleum of Armenia is the Mausoleum of Turkmen Emirs. The country's national hero is Viktor Hambartsumyan; Alek Manukyan; Movses Gorgisyan.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Tsitsernakaberd is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

Numerous organizations are working on a global level to improve the current state of affairs and to collaborate in order to establish and maintain constructive partnerships. Armenia is a member of the <u>Collective Security Treaty Organization (CSTO)</u>, <u>Commonwealth of Independent States</u> (CIS), <u>Eurasian Economic Union (EEU)</u>, <u>Organisation internationale de la Francophonie (OIF)</u>, and <u>United Nations (UN)</u>. Armenia collaborates with them to organize, analyze, and address various events and situations.

The tourism slogan of the country is "Visit Armenia, It is Beautiful" whereas, "Uty Uqq, Uty Uqulnıjp Mek Azg, Mek Mshakouyt - "One Nation, One Culture" is the official motto of the country.

Nikol Pashinyan is the current Prime minister of Armenia, and Armen Sarkissian is the President. Armenia has declared Armenian as the country's official language.
