

Botswana is a country in <u>Africa</u>. The official name of Botswana is the Republic of Botswana. It shares borders with 4 countries: <u>Namibia</u>, <u>Zambia</u>, <u>Zimbabwe</u>, and <u>South Africa</u>. The people of Botswana are called Motswana. The country is situated in Southern Africa, north of South Africa.

Botswana is divided into 10 rural districts, 7 urban districts, 21 sub-districts, and 519 villages. The capital of the country is Gaborone, which is also the largest city in Botswana.

The literacy rate in Botswana is 87.7%.

The country's total area is 581,730 km<sup>2</sup> (224,610 sq mi), and the total population is 2,351,627. The country's average elevation is 1,013 m (3,323 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Predominantly flat to gently rolling tableland; the Kalahari Desert in the southwest. The country's usual climate is semiarid; warm winters and hot summers.

The Botswana pula serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Botswana (BoB) is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Botswana is .bw and the country code is +267. Zebra is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Botswana National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Botswana National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Botswana is the Herero dress, and 30 September is designated as National

Day. In Botswana, the majority of the population practices Christianity, and Protestantism as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Botswana has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Botswana's national bird is the Kori bustard, while its national animal is the Zebra. The national flower is Sengaparile. The national tree of Botswana is the Marula, and the highest peak is Monalanong Hill.
