
BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

The country's total area is 153 km² (59 sq mi), and the total population is 30,237. The country's terrain can be defined as; Coral islands are relatively flat; volcanic islands are steep and hilly. The country's usual climate is subtropical; humid; with temperatures moderated by trade winds.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. The British Virgin Islands has 80 km of coastline.

The United States Dollar serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for the British Virgin Islands is .vg and the country code is +1. is the country's coat of arms.

The national dress of the British Virgin Islands is shorts & t-shirts, and 26 February is designated as

National Day. In the British Virgin Islands, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.
