Burkina Faso is a country in <u>Africa</u>. It shares borders with 6 countries: <u>Mali</u>, <u>Niger</u>, <u>Benin</u>, <u>Cote</u> <u>d'Ivoire</u>, <u>Ghana</u>, and <u>Togo</u>. The people of Burkina Faso are called Burkinabé. The country is situated in Western Africa, north of Ghana.

The country's total area is 274,200 km² (105,900 sq mi), and the total population is 20,903,273. The country's average elevation is 400 meters (1,300 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly flat to dissected, undulating plains; hills in the west and southeast. The country's usual climate can be described as; Tropical; warm, dry winters; hot, wet summers.

The West African CFA franc serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of West African States is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Burkina Faso is .bf and the country code is +226. White stallion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of Burkina Faso serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of Burkina Faso is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Burkina Faso is usually wearing a cotton shirt and trousers, embroidered shoes are worn by some men. 5th August is designated as National Day. In Burkina Faso, the majority of the population practices Islam, Christianity, and Indigenous beliefs as their religion.
