The Cape Verde Escudo serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Cape Verde is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Cape Verde is .cv and the country code is +238.

The Museu Etnográfico da Praia serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Museu Etnográfico da Praia is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Cape Verde is Western-style clothing, and the 5th of July is designated as National Day. In Cape Verde, the majority of the population practices Christianity Catholicism & other Christianity faith as their religion.
