The literacy rate in the Central African Republic is 36.8%.

The country's total area is 622,984 km² (240,535 sq mi), and the total population is 4,829,767. The country's average elevation is 1,640 feet (500 m), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Vast, flat to rolling, monotonous plateau; with scattered hills in the northeast and southwest. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, dry winters; mild to hot, wet summers.

The Central African CFA franc serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Central African States is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for the Central African Republic is .cf and the country code is +236. The elephant is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Boganda National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Boganda National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of the Central African Republic is the Lamba, and 1 December is designated as National Day. In the Central African Republic, the majority of the population practices Protestantism, and Catholicism as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the

significance of nature, the Central African Republic has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols.
