Chad is a landlocked country in <u>Africa</u>. The official name of Chad is the Republic of Chad. It shares borders with 6 countries: <u>Libya</u>, <u>Sudan</u>, the <u>Central African Republic</u>, <u>Cameroon</u>, <u>Nigeria</u>, and <u>Niger</u>. The people of Chad are called Chadians. The country is situated in Central Africa, south of Libya.

Etymology discusses where a term is considered to have originated from and how its meaning has changed over time. Etymology has been a factor in the naming of countries all across the world, and Chad has also been influenced. The etymology of Chad can be defined as; "Lake", from Lake Chad in the country's southwest, whose name derives from the Kanuri tsade ("lake").

The country has the time zone UTC+1 (WAT) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Chad is divided into 23 regions. The capital of the country is N'Djamena, which is also the largest city in Chad.

The literacy rate in Chad is 22.3%.

The country's total area is 1,284,000 km² (496,000 sq mi), and the total population is 16,425,864. The country's average elevation is 543 m (1,781 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Broad, arid plains in the center, desert in the north, mountains in the northwest, and lowlands in the south. The country's usual climate is tropical in the south, and desert in the north.

The Central African CFA franc serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Central African States is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Chad is .td and the country code is +235. Goat (north); Lion (south) is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Chad National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Chad National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Chad is the Jalabiyas worn by men in public, along with white turban-like headgear known as a tagiya. 11 August is designated as National Day. In Chad, the majority of the population practices Islam, Christianity, and Folk as their religion.

François Tombalbaye is the founder of Chad. The country's national anthem was written by Louis Gidrol and others, and composed by Paul Villard.

The country's national hero is Idriss Déby.

Numerous organizations are working on a global level to improve the current state of affairs and to collaborate in order to establish and maintain constructive partnerships. Chad is a member of the <u>African Union (AU)</u>, <u>Organisation internationale de la Francophonie (OIF)</u>, <u>Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC)</u>, and <u>United Nations (UN)</u>. Chad collaborates with them to organize, analyze, and address various events and situations.
