The country's usual climate is tropical; hot and humid in the equatorial river basin; cooler and drier in the southern highlands; cooler and wetter in eastern highlands; north of the Equator - wet season (April to October), dry season (December to February); south of Equator - wet season (November to March), dry season (April to October).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. The Democratic Republic of the Congo has 37 km of coastline.

The Congolese franc serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of the Congo is

recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for the Democratic Republic of the Congo is .cd and the country code is +243. is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of the Congo serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of the Congo is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.
