
CZECH REPUBLIC

The country's usual climate is temperate; cool summers; cold, cloudy, humid winters.

The Czech koruna serves as the national unit of currency, and the Czech National Bank is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for the Czech Republic is .cz and the country code is +420. Double-tailed lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Národní Muzeum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Národní Muzeum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.
