
DAGESTAN

Situated on the Caspian Sea, in the North Caucasus of Eastern Europe, Dagestan is a republic of the Russian Federation. The official name of Dagestan is the Republic of Dagestan.

The country has the time zone UTC+3 (MSK) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

The country's capital and largest city, Makhachkala, is situated in the center of the country on the Caspian Sea coast. The monetary unit is Rubles; the country code is 872, while the official domain is ".ru."

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Dagestan has 3,735 km of coastline.

As a part of the old communist Soviet Union, Dagestan's official motto is "Workers of all countries, Unite!" The founder and national hero is Imam Shamil, who was the political, military, and spiritual leader of the Caucasian resistance to Imperial Russia in the 19th century. The national day is the 20th of January, as the country was established during the Russian Civil War in 1921. The national colors of Dagestan are green, blue, and red, which create the national flag as horizontal bands, respectively.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of the Republic of Dagestan serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of the Republic of Dagestan is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Dagestan and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Wrestling is considered the country's national sport.

The national bird of the nation is the eagle, which appears on the coat of arms. The country's national dish is Khinkali, a type of dumpling found in the North Caucasus that is similar to Turkish manti or Italian ravioli. The national dress is Chokha, which is a typically white woolen coat with a high neck. Dagestan's national sport is Wrestling, while the national poet is regarded as Rasul

Gamzatov. He is quite an important figure in Soviet countries, and he has a statue in Makhachkala, which is the country's national monument. The national Dagestan airline is called OJSC Dagestan Airlines.
