Egypt is a country that links northeast Africa with the Middle East dating back to the pharaohs' reign. We can't talk about Egypt without mentioning the great Pyramids! <u>The Great Pyramid of Giza</u> is the most ancient and largest in Egypt thus it's the national monument,

"Tahtib" which refers to dancing with a stick, is the national folk dance that is performed to the tune of *Mizmar*. The national dress is the "Kaftan" worn over the *gallabiyya*; a long garment with long sleeves.

Almost everybody is familiar with Egypt's Kushari! This national dish, popular street food, is made of rice, lentils, chickpeas, and macaroni, topped with hot tomato sauce and fried onions! Now whether it's daytime or nighttime, Egyptians love their cup of tea! Tea is the national drink.
