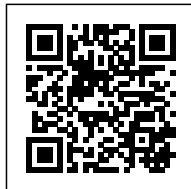


FLANDERS

Flanders is a country in [Europe](#). The people of Flanders are called Flemish, and the country is situated in Northern Belgium.

Etymology discusses where a term is considered to have originated from and how its meaning has changed over time. The etymology of Flanders can be defined as; Flanders and Flemish are likely derived from the Frisian flāndra and flāmisk (in Old Frisian flamsk), the roots of which are Germanic *flaumaz meaning "overflow, flooding".

An ethnicity is a group or sub-group of people who are connected based on common characteristics which may include religion, origin, language, traditions, or culture. The ethnic groups in Flanders include Flemish, Walloon, and mixed/other.

Flanders is known for being one of the world's major fashion hubs. The national dish of Flanders is Moules-frites. Jenever, in addition to being a traditional beverage, is one of the country's national drinks. The national instrument of Flanders is Saxophone.

The country has the time zone UTC+1 (CET) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Brussels is the capital of Flanders. The literacy rate in Flanders is 98%.

The country's total area is 13,625 km² (5,261 sq mi), and the total population is 11,589,623. The country's average elevation is 5 m (16.5ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly flat coastal plains in the northwest. Then, it transitions into a slightly more elevated central plateau in the center. The country's usual climate can be described as; Temperate; mild winters, cool summers; rainy, humid, and cloudy.

The Euro serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Flanders is .be and the country code is +32. The Flemish Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of the Resistance serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of the Resistance is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Flanders is the smock and beret, worn by men, and the classic huntress dress is favored by Belgian women. 21 July is designated as National Day. In Flanders, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and

food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Flanders has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Flanders's national bird is the Common Kestrel, while its national animal is the Flemish Lion. The national flower is Red Poppy. The national tree of Flanders is the *Taxus Baccata*, and the highest peak is Hagelstein.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Flanders and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Cycling is considered the country's national sport.

Poetry is a highly valued form of art, and many poets are considered significant national symbols of the country. The national poet of Flanders is Emile Verhaeren.

Leopold I of Saxe-Coburg is the founder of Flanders. The country's national anthem was written by Hippoliet Van Peene, and composed by Karel Miry.

Mausoleums are buildings dedicated to holding someone's remains. It serves as a reminder of the nation's revolutionary fighters who sacrificed their lives for the country. Mausoleums are one of the most significant historical landmarks. The national mausoleum of Flanders is Flanders Field American Cemetery. The country's national hero is Ambiorix.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Flanders Fields Memorial Garden is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

The tourism slogan of the country is "The Place to Be" whereas, "Eendracht maakt macht - "Unity gives Strength" is the official motto of the country.

Jan Jambon is the current Prime minister and President of Flanders.

Flanders has declared Dutch as the country's official language.
