
## **THE GAMBIA**

The literacy rate in the Gambia is 42.0%.

The country's total area is 10,689 km<sup>2</sup> (4,127 sq mi), and the total population is 2,416,668. The country's average elevation is 34 m (112 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Flood plain of the Gambia River flanked by some low hills. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, rainy season (June to November); cooler, dry season (November to May).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. The Gambia has 80 km of coastline.

The Gambian dalasi serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of the Gambia is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for the Gambia is .gm and the country code is +220. Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of the Gambia is the Grandmuba, and 18 February is designated as National Day.

In The Gambia, the majority of the population practices Islam as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, the Gambia has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. The Gambia's national animal is the Spotted hyena.
