The country's total area is 6.8 km² (2.6 sq mi), and the total population is 33,691. The country's average elevation is 213 m (699 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; A narrow coastal lowland that borders the Rock of Gibraltar. The country's usual climate is Mediterranean with mild winters and warm summers.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Gibraltar has 12 km of coastline.

The Gibraltar pound serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Gibraltar is .gi and the country code is +350. Insignia of the Mountain of Calpe is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Gibraltar National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Gibraltar National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

10 September is designated as National Day. In Gibraltar, the majority of the population practices Roman Catholicism as their religion.
