The country's total area is 2,166,086 km² (836,330 sq mi), and the total population is 56,367. The country's average elevation is 1,792 m (5,879 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Flat to gradually sloping icecap covering all but a narrow, mountainous, barren, rocky coast. The country's usual climate can be described as; Arctic to subarctic; with cool summers, and cold winters.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Greenland has 44,087 km of coastline.

The Danish krone serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Greenland is .gl and the country code is +299.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. Greenland National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. Greenland National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Greenland is the North Greenlandic clothing, and 21 June is designated as National Day. In Greenland, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Greenland has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols.
