

The country's usual climate is subtropical monsoon; cool and humid in winter, hot and rainy from spring through summer, and warm and sunny in fall.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Hong Kong has 456 km of coastline.

The Hong Kong dollar serves as the national unit of currency, and Hong Kong Monetary Authority is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Hong Kong is .hk and the country code is +852. Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Hong Kong Museum of History serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Hong Kong Museum of History is home to a large

collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Hong Kong is the Qipao dress, and 11 March is designated as National Day. In Hong Kong, the majority of the population practices Chinese Folk Religions, Buddhism, Taoism, and Christianity as their religion.
