Jersey is a country in <u>Europe</u>. It shares borders with the <u>United Kingdom</u>. The people of Jersey are called Jersian. The country is situated in Western Europe, an island in the English Channel, northwest of France.

An ethnicity is a group or sub-group of people who are connected based on common characteristics which may include religion, origin, language, traditions, or culture. The ethnic groups in Jersey include Jersey, British, Portuguese, Polish, Irish, French, European, and Asian.

British European Airways is the national airline of Jersey. The national colors of the country are red and white. The emoji flag of the country is ????????, and the ISO code is JE.

Jersey is known for its beautiful beaches and coastal cliffs. The national dish of Jersey is Bean Crock (les pais au fou).

The country has the time zone UTC±00:00 (GMT) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Jersey is divided into 12 parishes. The capital of the country is Saint Helier, which is also the largest city in Jersey.

The literacy rate in Jersey is 100%.

The country's total area is 118.2 km² (45.6 sq mi), and the total population is 9,288,994. The country's terrain can be defined as; Gently rolling plain with low, rugged hills along the north coast. The country's usual climate can be described as; Temperate; with mild winters and cool summers.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Jersey has 70 km of coastline.

The Pound sterling, the Jersey pound (£) serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Jersey is .je and the country code is +44.

The national dress of Jersey is Guernsey, and 9 May is designated as National Day. In Jersey, the majority of the population practices Anglican Catholicism as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Jersey has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Jersey's national bird is Atlantic Puffin, while its national animal is the Crapauds / Jersey Cow. The national flower is the Jersey Lily, whereas the Blueberry is the country's national fruit. The highest peak is Les Platons.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Jersey and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Football is considered the country's national sport.

The country's national anthem was written by Gerard Le Feuvre, and composed by Gerard Le Feuvre.

Mausoleums are buildings dedicated to holding someone's remains. It serves as a reminder of the nation's revolutionary fighters who sacrificed their lives for the country. Mausoleums are one of the most significant historical landmarks. The national mausoleum of Jersey is Jersey dolmens. The country's national hero is Queen Elizabeth II.

The tourism slogan of the country is "The Island Break" whereas, "Dieu et Mon Droit (French) "God and My Right" is the official motto of the country.

Stephen Dalton (Lieutenant Governor) is the current Prime minister of Jersey, and Elizabeth II (Monarch) is the President.

Jersey has declared English, Jèrriais, and French as the country's official languages.
