The country's total area is 30,355 km² (11,720 sq mi), and the total population is 2,142,249. The country's average elevation is 2,161 m (7,090 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly highland with plateaus, hills, and mountains. The country's usual climate is temperate; cool to cold, dry winters; hot, wet summers.

The Lesotho loti serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of Lesotho is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Lesotho is .is and the country code is +266. Upon a Basotho shield: Gules a crocodile embowed Azure is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. Lesotho National Museum and Arts Galary serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. Lesotho National Museum and Arts Galary is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Lesotho is the Seshoeshoe. 4 October is designated as National Day. In

Lesotho, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.
