

Liberia is a country in <u>Africa</u>. The official name of Liberia is the Republic of Liberia. It shares borders with 3 countries: <u>Sierra Leone</u>, <u>Guinea</u>, and <u>Côte d'Ivoire</u>. The people of Liberia are called Liberians. The country is situated in Western Africa, bordering the North Atlantic Ocean, between Cote d'Ivoire and Sierra Leone.

Etymology has been a factor in the naming of countries all across the world, and Liberia has also been influenced. The etymology of Liberia can be defined as; From the Latin liber "free", so named because the country was established as a homeland for freed (liberated) African-American slaves.

Liberia is known for being the first African country with a female President. The national dish of Liberia is Dumboy. Ginger beer, in addition to being a traditional beverage, is one of the country's national drinks. The national instrument of Liberia is the Belly harp.

The country has the time zone UTC (GMT) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Liberia is divided into 15 counties with 60+ districts. The capital of the country is Monrovia, which is also the largest city in Liberia.

The literacy rate in Liberia is 42.9%.

The country's total area is 111,369 km² (43,000 sq mi), and the total population is 5,057,681. The country's average elevation is 243 m (797 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly flat to rolling coastal plains rising to roll plateaus and low mountains in the northeast. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, humid; dry winters with hot days and cool to cold nights; wet, cloudy summers with frequent heavy showers.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Liberia has 579 km of coastline.

The Liberian dollar serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of Liberia is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Liberia is .lr and the country code is +231. The white star is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of Liberia serves the same purpose and is considered

one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of Liberia is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

Traditionally men wear short or long pants with a loose round-neck shirt, and women wear a long wrap skirt called "Lappa" and a loose top called "Bubba", which are considered the national dress in Liberia. 26 July is designated as National Day. In Liberia, the majority of the population practices Christianity Protestantism, Catholicism, and Islam as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Liberia has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Liberia's national animal is the Lion. The national flower is Pepper Flower, whereas the national tree of Liberia is the Palm tree, and the highest peak is Mount Wuteve.

Mythical creatures can be found in the literature and mythologies of many different nations. They represent imaginative representations of various creatures, humans, or hybrids. They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Liberia is Anansi.
