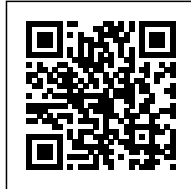
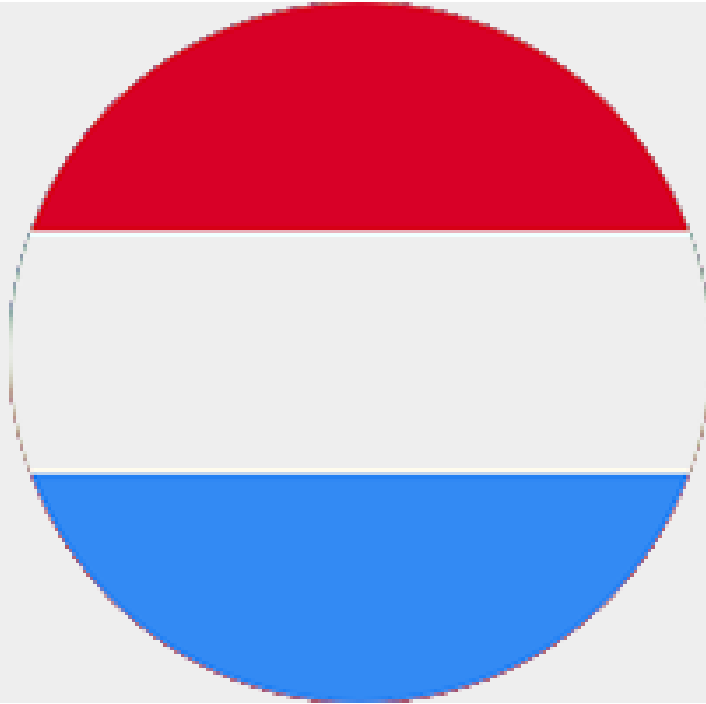


LUXEMBOURG

Luxembourg is a landlocked country in [Europe](#). The official name of Luxembourg is the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. It shares borders with 3 countries: [Belgium](#), [France](#), and [Germany](#). The people of Luxembourg are called Luxembourg. The country is situated in Western Europe, between France and Germany.

The literacy rate in Luxembourg is 100%.

The country's total area is 2,586.4 km² (998.6 sq mi), and the total population is 625,978. The country's average elevation is 325 m (1,066 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Mostly gently rolling uplands with broad, shallow valleys; uplands to slightly mountainous in the north; steep slope down to Moselle flood plain in the southeast. The country's usual climate is modified continental with mild winters, and cool summers.

The Euro serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of Luxembourg is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Luxembourg is .lu and the country code is +352. Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Luxembourg National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Luxembourg National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the

country.

The national dress of Luxembourg is men wearing blue smocks and dark trousers colorfully accented by the ribbons and pompoms they wear. 23 June is designated as National Day. In Luxembourg, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Luxembourg has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Luxembourg's national bird is the Goldcrest, while its national animal is the Lion.
