Malawi is a landlocked country in <u>Africa</u>. The official name of Malawi is the Republic of Malawi. It shares borders with 3 countries: <u>Zambia</u>, <u>Tanzania</u>, and <u>Mozambique</u>. The country's usual climate is sub-tropical; rainy season (November to May); dry season (May to November).

The Malawian kwacha serves as the national unit of currency, and the Reserve Bank of Malawi is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Malawi is .mw and the country code is +265.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Museum of Malawi serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Museum of Malawi is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Malawi is the Chitenge, and 6 July is designated as National Day. In Malawi, the

majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

To emphasize the significance of nature, Malawi has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols.
