
Micronesia

Micronesia is a country in <u>Australia/Oceania</u>. The official name of Micronesia is the Federated States of Micronesia. The people of Micronesia are called Micronesians. The country is in Oceania, an island group in the North Pacific Ocean, about three-quarters of the way from Hawaii to Indonesia.

The etymology of Micronesia can be defined as; Coined from the Greek words mikros (μικρός "small") and nesos (νῆσος "island") – "small islands".

Micronesia is divided into 4 states and 70+ municipalities. Weno is Micronesia's largest city, while Palikir serves as the capital.

The literacy rate in Micronesia is 98.8%.

The country's total area is 702 km², and the total population is 548,914. The country's average elevation is 2.1 m (7 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Islands that vary geologically from high mountainous islands to low, coral atolls; volcanic outcroppings on Pohnpei, Kosrae, and Chuuk. The country's usual climate can be described as; Tropical; with heavy year-round rainfall, especially in the eastern islands; located on the southern edge of the typhoon belt with occasionally severe damage.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Micronesia has 6,112 km of coastline.

The United States Dollar serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Micronesia is .fm and the country code is +691.

The national dress of Micronesia is the Pohnpeian skirt, and 3 November is designated as National Day.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the

significance of nature, Micronesia has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Chuuk Flying Fox is both the national bird and animal of Micronesia. The national flower is Frangipanis, and the highest peak is Agrihan High Point.

They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Micronesia is Nei Tituaabine.
