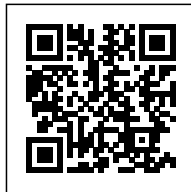
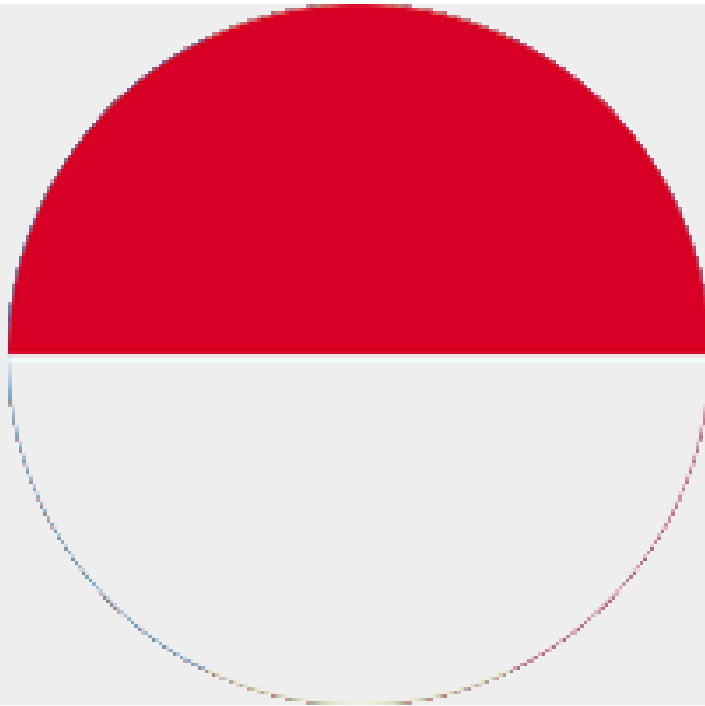


# MONACO

Monaco is a country in [Europe](#). The official name of Monaco is the Principality of Monaco. It shares borders with [France](#). The people of Monaco are called Monacans. The country is situated in Western Europe, bordering the Mediterranean Sea on the southern coast of France, near the border with Italy.

The country's usual climate is Mediterranean with mild, wet winters and hot, dry summers.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Monaco has 4.1 km of coastline.

The Euro serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Monaco is .mc and the country code is +377.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Nouveau Musée National de Monaco serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. Nouveau Musée National de Monaco is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Monaco is men wearing knee pants, with a color full of sashes wrapped around their waist and strings tied around their necks. 19 November is designated as National Day. In Monaco, the majority of the population practices Christianity and Roman Catholicism as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the

significance of nature, Monaco has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Monaco's national animals are the Hedgehog, Rabbit, and Wood mouse. The national flower is Red Carnation, whereas the national tree of Monaco is the Carob tree, and the highest peak is Chemin des Révoires.
