The country's usual climate is tropical to subtropical.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Mozambique has 2,470 km of coastline.

The Mozambican metical serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Mozambique is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Mozambique is .mz and the country code is +258.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. Museu de Historia Natural serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. Museu de Historia Natural is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Mozambique is the Capulana, and 25 June is designated as National Day. In

Mozambique, the majority of the population practices Christianity, Protestantism, and other Christianity faiths as their religion.
