

Nauru is a country in <u>Australia/Oceania</u>. The official name of Nauru is the Republic of Nauru. The people of Nauru are called Nauruan. The country is in Oceania, an island in the South Pacific Ocean, south of the Marshall Islands.

The country has the time zone UTC+12 followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

Nauru is divided into 14 districts. The capital of the country is Yaren, which is also the largest city in Nauru.

The literacy rate in Nauru is 96.5%.

The country's total area is 21 km² (8.1 sq mi), and the total population is 10,824. The country's average elevation is 300-100 m, whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Sandy Beach rising to a fertile ring around raised coral reefs with a phosphate plateau in the center. The country's usual climate is tropical with a monsoonal pattern; rainy season (November to February).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Nauru has 30 km of coastline.

The Australian dollar serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Nauru is .nr and the country code is +674. Twelve-pointed star is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Nauru Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Nauru Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Nauru is short trousers and light shirts, and 31 January is designated as National Day. In Nauru, the majority of the population practices Nauru Congregational Church as

their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Nauru has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. The Great Frigatebird is both the national bird and animal of Nauru. The national tree of Nauru is Tomano, and the highest peak is Command Ridge.

They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Nauru is Areop Enap.

Hammer DeRoburt is the founder of Nauru. The country's national anthem was written by Margaret Hendrie, and composed by Laurence Henry Hicks.

The country's national hero is Hammer DeRoburt.

Numerous organizations are working on a global level to improve the current state of affairs and to collaborate in order to establish and maintain constructive partnerships. Nauru is a member of the <u>Commonwealth of Nations</u>, <u>Pacific Community (PC)</u>, and <u>United Nations (UN)</u>. "God's will first" is the official motto of the country, and Lionel Aingimea is the current President of Nauru.

Nauru has declared Nauruan as the country's official language.
