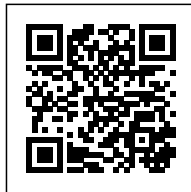


# NORFOLK ISLAND

Norfolk Island is a country in [Australia/Oceania](#). The official name of Norfolk Island is the Territory of Norfolk Island. The people of Norfolk Island are called Norfolk Islanders. The country is located in the Pacific Ocean between New Zealand.

The etymology of Norfolk Island can be defined as; Named after the Duke of Norfolk.

Norfolk Island is known for Norfolk Island Pine, which was first seen by Captain James Cook in 1774. The national dish of Norfolk Island is Pilhi.

The country has the time zone UTC+11:00 (NFT) followed by d/m/yyyy as the standard date format.

Burnt Pine is Norfolk Island's largest city, while Kingston serves as the capital.

The literacy rate in Norfolk Island is 99%.

The country's total area is 34.6 km<sup>2</sup> (13.4 sq mi), and the total population is 238,005. The country's average elevation is 360ft, whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Volcanic formations with mostly rolling plains. The country's usual climate is subtropical; mild, with little seasonal temperature variation.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Norfolk Island has 145 km of coastline.

The Australian dollar serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Norfolk Island is .nf and the country code is +672. Pine (*Araucaria heterophylla*) is the country's coat of arms.

8 June is designated as National Day. In Norfolk Island, the majority of the population practices Protestant, Anglican, Uniting Church in Australia, and Roman Catholicism as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Norfolk Island has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Norfolk Island's national bird is the Green parrot. The island has no mammals or amphibians, and the only reptiles (a skink and a gecko) are seen exclusively. The national flower is Hibiscus, the national

tree of Norfolk Island is the Araucaria heterophylla, and the highest peak is Mount Bates.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Norfolk Island and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Rugby is considered the country's national sport.

Captain James Cook is the founder of Norfolk Island.

Mausoleums are buildings dedicated to holding someone's remains. It serves as a reminder of the nation's revolutionary fighters who sacrificed their lives for the country. Mausoleums are one of the most significant historical landmarks. The national mausoleum of Norfolk Island is Cemetery Bay.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Captain Cook Monument is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.

"Inasmuch" is the official motto of the country.

David Hurley (Governor General) is the current Prime minister of Norfolk Island, and King Charles III is the President.

Norfolk Island has declared English and Norfuk as the country's official languages.
