
SAINT BARTHÉLEMY

Saint Barthélemy is a country in <u>North America</u>. It shares borders with 5 countries: the <u>British Virgin Islands</u>, <u>Saba</u>, <u>Saint Kitts and Nevis</u>, <u>Sint Maarten</u>, and <u>Anguilla</u>. The people of Saint Barthélemy are called Barthelemois. The country is in the Caribbean, an island between the Caribbean Sea and the North Atlantic Ocean; located in the Leeward Islands (northern) group; Saint Barthelemy lies east of the US Virgin Islands.

Etymology has been a factor in the naming of countries all across the world, and Saint Barthélemy has also been influenced. The etymology of Saint Barthélemy can be defined as; The island was named by Christopher Columbus for his younger brother Bartholomew Columbus in 1493.

Saint Barthélemy is known for its stunning beaches. The national dish of Saint Barthélemy is Accras. Ti-Punch cocktail, in addition to being a traditional beverage, is one of the country's national drinks. The national instrument of Saint Barthélemy is Steelpan.

The country has the time zone UTC-4:00 (AST) followed by dd/mm/yyyy as the standard date format.

The capital of the country is Gustavia, which is also the largest city in Saint Barthélemy.

The literacy rate in Saint Barthélemy is 100%.

The country's total area is 25 km² (9.7 sq mi), and the total population is 9,932. The country's average elevation is 921 ft, whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Hilly, almost completely surrounded by shallow-water reefs, with plentiful beaches. The country's usual climate is tropical, with practically no variation in temperature; has two seasons (dry and humid).

The Euro serves as the national unit of currency. The domain for Saint Barthélemy is bl.fr and the country code is +590. The flag of Saint Barthélemy is the French tricolor.

The national dress of Saint Barthélemy is the Madras, and 10 May is designated as National Day. In Saint Barthélemy, the majority of the population practices Anglicans, Evangelists, and Catholics as their religion.

significance of nature, Saint Barthélemy has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Saint Barthélemy's national bird is the Blackbellied WhistlingDuck (unofficial), while the national flower is the Lily, whereas Tropical fruits are the country's national fruit. The highest peak is Morne du Vitet.

Sports have always played an important role in developing the social and cultural structure of Saint Barthélemy and other countries. When it comes to designating a sport as the official symbol, Football is considered the country's national sport.

Bruno Magras is the founder of Saint Barthélemy. The country's national anthem was written and composed by Claude Joseph Rouget de Lisle.

Sylvie Feucher (Prefect) is the current Prime minister of Saint Barthélemy, and Emmanuel Macron is the President.

Saint Barthélemy has declared French, Saint-Barthélemy French, Antillean, and Creole as the country's official languages.
