Sao Tome and Principe is a country in Africa. The official name of Sao Tome and Principe is the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe. The literacy rate in Sao Tome and Principe is 90.1%.

The country's total area is 1,001 km² (386 sq mi), and the total population is 219,159. The country's average elevation is 137 m, whereas the country's terrain is volcanic and mountainous. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, and humid; one rainy season (October to May).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Sao Tome and Principe has 209 km of coastline.

The São Tomé and Príncipe dobra serve as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of São Tomé and Príncipe is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Sao Tome and Principe is .st and the country code is +239.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. São Sebastião Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. São Sebastião Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Sao Tome and Principe is the Kente, and 12 July is designated as National Day. In Sao Tome and Principe, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Sao Tome and Principe have selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Sao Tome and Principe's national animal is the Sao Tome Shrew. The country's national hero is Rei Amador.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Obo National Park is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.
