
Sierra Leone

The country's total area is 71,740 km² (27,700 sq mi), and the total population is 7,976,983. The country's average elevation is 279 m (915 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Coastal belt of mangrove swamps, wooded hill country, upland plateau, and mountains in the east. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, humid; summer rainy season (May to December); winter dry season (December to April).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Sierra Leone has 402 km of coastline.

The Sierra Leonean leone serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of Sierra Leone is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Sierra Leone is .sl and the country code is +232. Lion is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Sierra Leone National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Sierra Leone National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Sierra Leone is the Country cloth or kpokpo, and 27 April is designated as National Day. In Sierra Leone, the majority of the population practices Islam, Christianity, and other faith as their religion.

To emphasize the significance of nature, Sierra Leone has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols.
