The country's total area is 261 km² (101 sq mi), and the total population is 53,199. The country's average elevation is 1,156 m, whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Volcanic with mountainous interiors. The country's usual climate is tropical, tempered by constant sea breezes; little seasonal temperature variation; rainy season (May to November).

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Saint Kitts and Nevis have 135 km of coastline.

The Eastern Caribbean dollar serves as the national unit of currency, and the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Saint Kitts and Nevis is .kn and the country code is +869. Country Above Self is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum of Saint Kitts serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum of Saint Kitts is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Saint Kitts and Nevis is the Madras, and 19 September is designated as National Day. In Saint Kitts and Nevis, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.
