Togo is a country in <u>Africa</u>. The official name of Togo is the Togolese Republic. It shares borders with 3 countries: <u>Ghana</u>, <u>Benin</u>, and <u>Burkina Faso</u>. Togo is divided into 5 regions and 30 prefectures. Lomé is Togo's largest city, while Lome serves as the capital.

The literacy rate in Togo is 63.7%.

The country's total area is 56,785 km<sup>2</sup> (21,925 sq mi), and the total population is 8,278,724. The country's average elevation is 236 m (774 ft), whereas the country's terrain can be defined as; Gently rolling savanna in the north; central hills; southern plateau; low coastal plain with extensive lagoons and marshes. The country's usual climate is tropical; hot, humid in the south; semiarid in the north.

The area of land next to a sea is called the coast, and a coastline is defined as the line where land and sea meet. Togo has 56 km of coastline.

The West African CFA franc serves as the national unit of currency, and the Central Bank of West African States is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Togo is .tg and the country code is +228.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The Togo National Museum serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The Togo National Museum is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Togo is the Kente fabric, and 27 April is designated as National Day. In Togo, the majority of the population practices Christianity, Traditional faiths, and Islam as their religion.

Nature is a blessing from God and we must protect it because it provides us with the oxygen and food to survive. It also helps to keep our environment beautiful and clean. To emphasize the significance of nature, Togo has selected a few forces of nature as national symbols. Togo's national animal is the Lion. The national flower is the Rose, and the highest peak is Mont Agou.

They are known for their specific features, supernatural abilities, and distinctive appearance. The mythical creature of Togo is Adze.

Due to their unique qualities and rich cultural or historical backgrounds, national monuments around the world are of great importance. Independence Monument, Lome is recognized as the national monument of the country. It attracts visitors from all around the world.
