

The Pound sterling serves as the national unit of currency, and the Bank of England is recognized as the country's central bank. The domain for Wales is gov. wales and the country code is +44. Royal Badge of Wales is the country's coat of arms.

Museums are known to educate and connect visitors with the nation's history, culture, civilization, art, and architecture. The National Museum Cardiff serves the same purpose and is considered one of the most significant tourist attractions. The National Museum Cardiff is home to a large collection of artifacts. It has been designated as the national museum of the country.

The national dress of Wales is the Bedgowns, and 21 March is designated as National Day. In Wales, the majority of the population practices Christianity as their religion.
